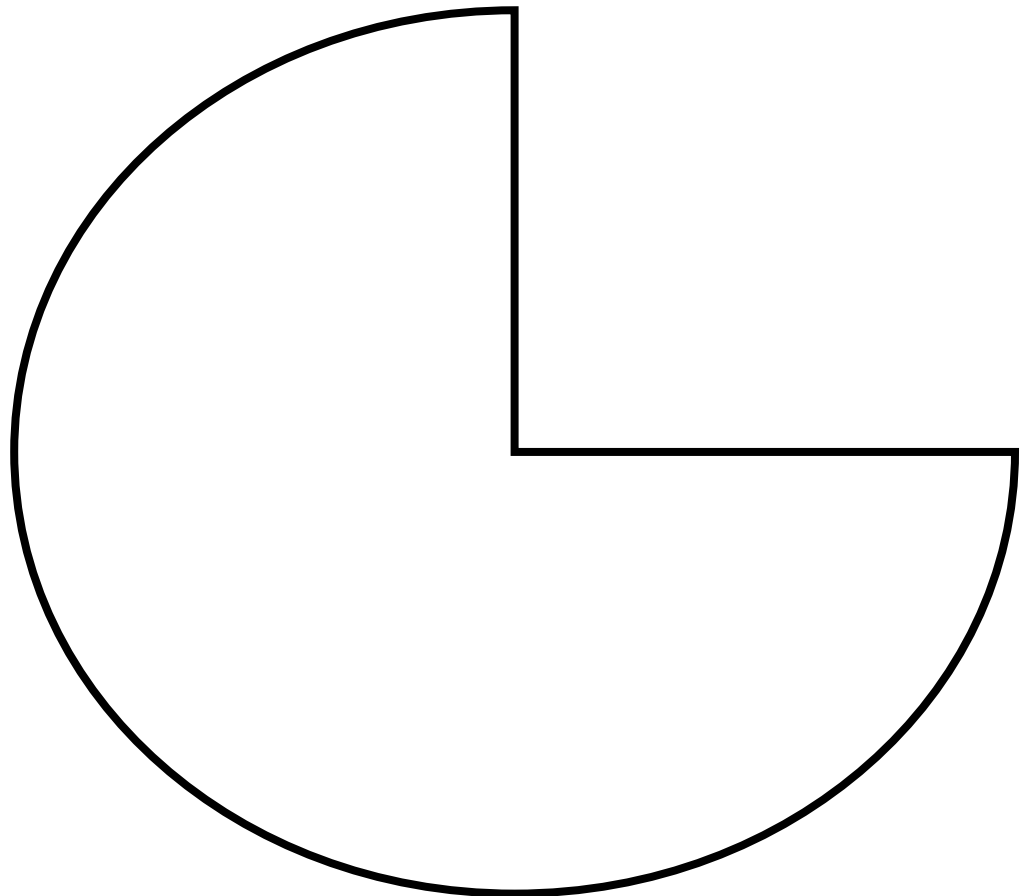


Make your own angle eater

Why not make your own angle eater. You can make it into anything you want (a fish, a monster, an alien)! Then cut it out and go on a hunt for right angles. Right angles are angles that fit exactly into the gap (mouth).

Remember! If the angle is smaller it is an 'acute' angle. If it is bigger it is an 'obtuse' angle.
