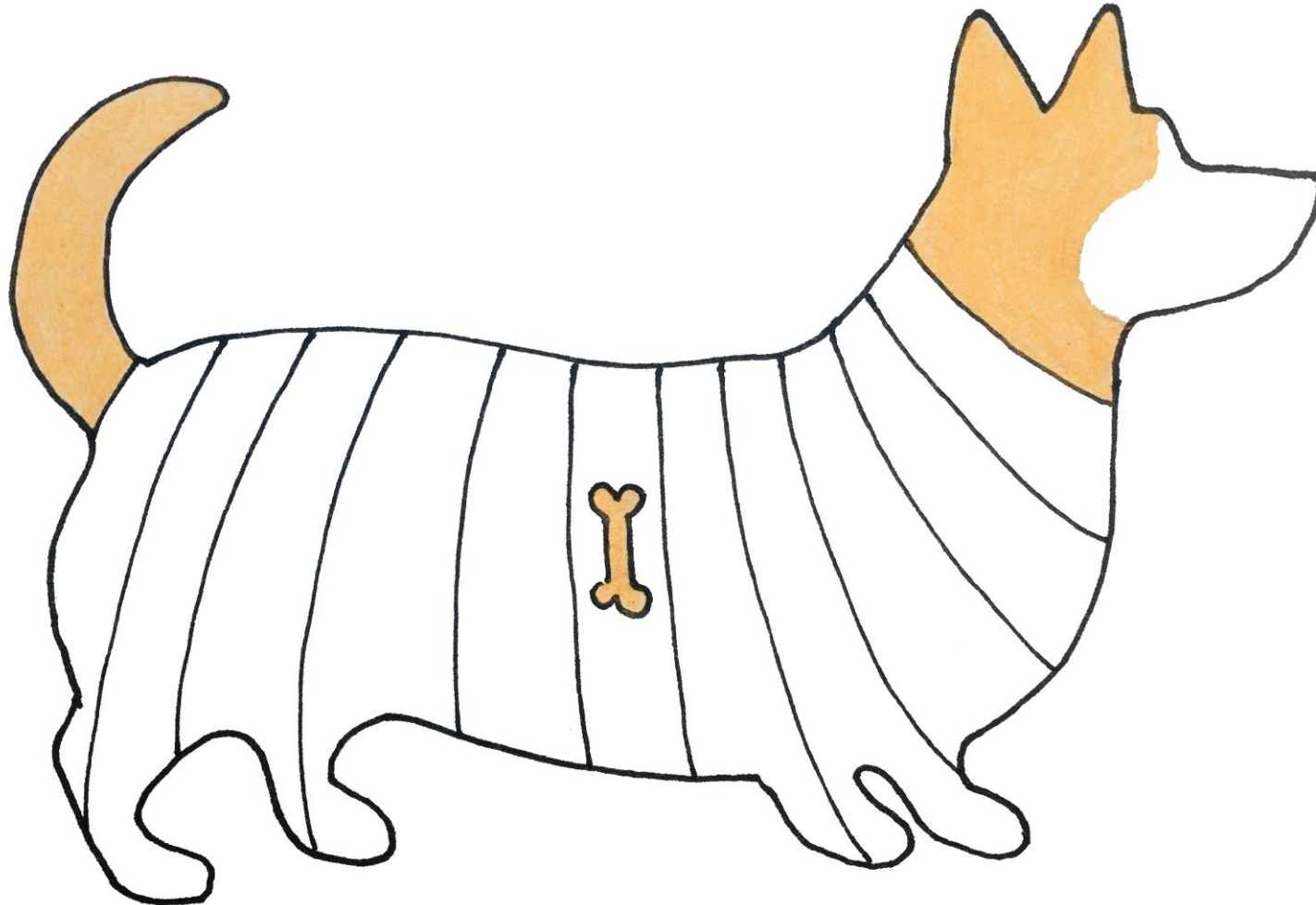


Corgi Heads and Tails

Corgi Heads and Tails

What you will need:

Two players, one coin and two counters (coloured paper, Lego bricks or small toys will work).

How to play:

1. One player is heads and the other player is tails.
2. Each player places their counter on the bone in the middle of the Queen's corgi.
3. Toss a coin. If the coin lands on heads, the heads player moves one space towards the head. If the coin lands on tails, the tails player moves one space towards the tail.
4. The first player to reach the head or the tail of the corgi wins!

What is the lowest number of times you can toss the coin to win?

What is the highest number of times you can toss the coin to win?
