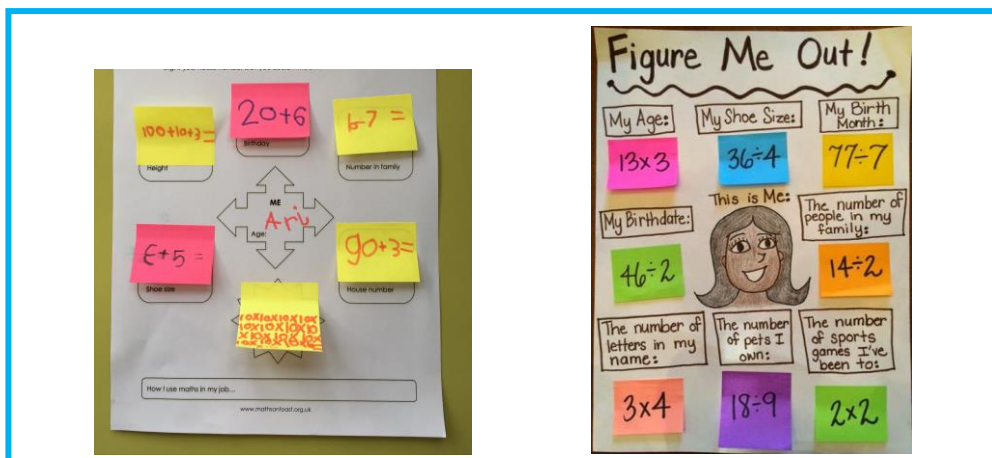


Maths of Me

Numbers are part of you, from the month you were born to the size of your shoe.

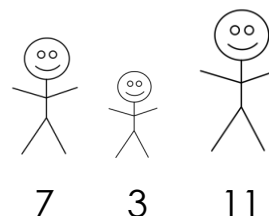
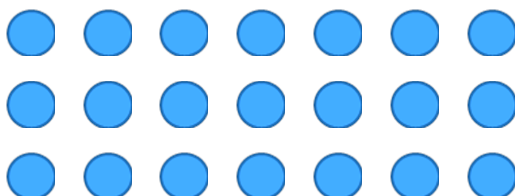


Create a Maths of Me Profile and challenge others to 'figure you out'!

1. Fill the Maths of Me profile sheet with YOUR numbers.
2. Challenge others to find your numbers by writing clues on post-it notes/small pieces of paper (perhaps using calculations, pictures, arrays, or a number line).

For example if your birthday is 21st of the month you could write:

$$20+1=21$$
$$3 \times 7=21$$
$$42 \div 2=21$$



3. Don't forget to cover your answer numbers up!
4. Reveal to see if they are correct!
