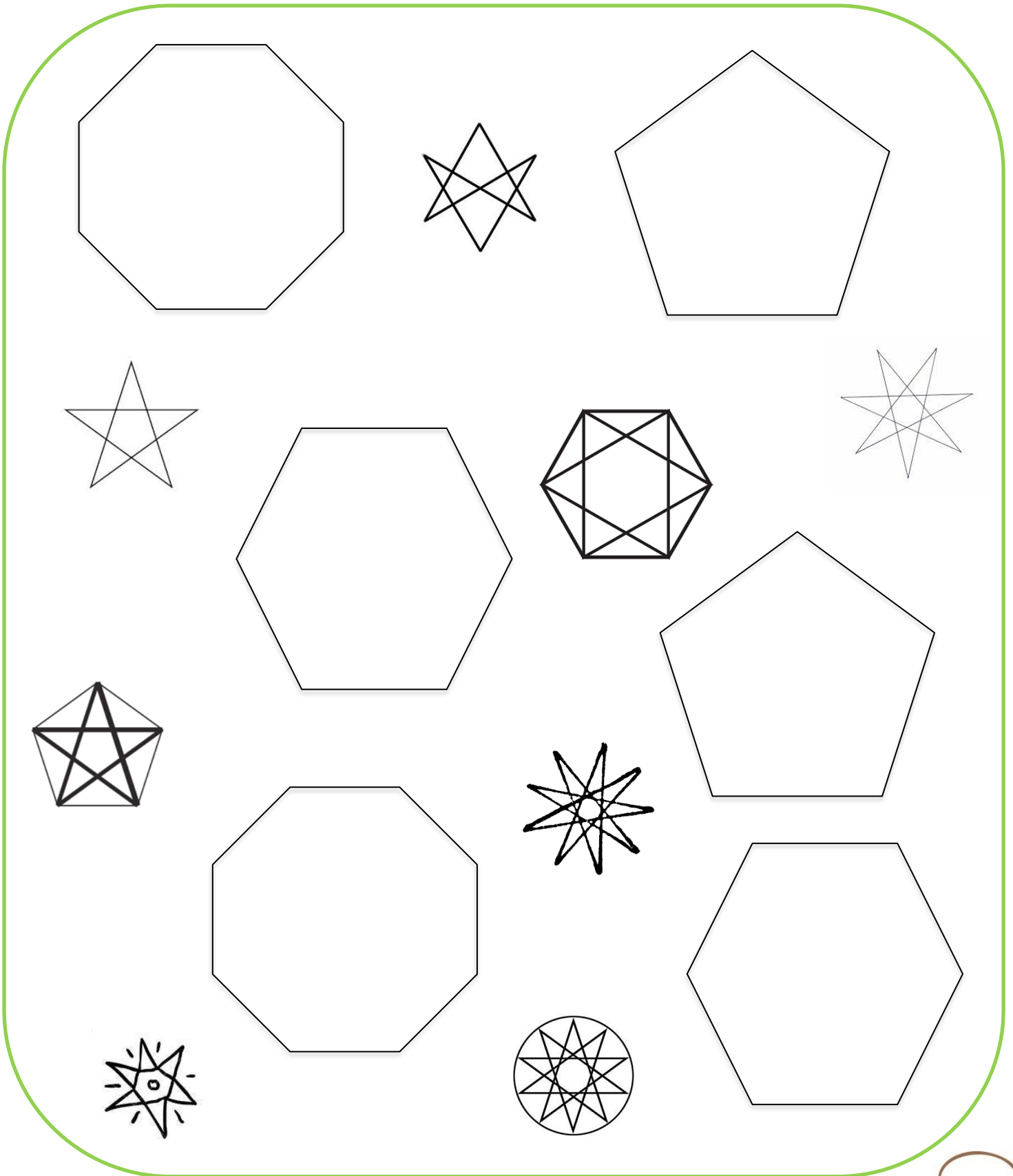


# Doodling Stars

An eight pointed star can be made by drawing two overlapping squares:



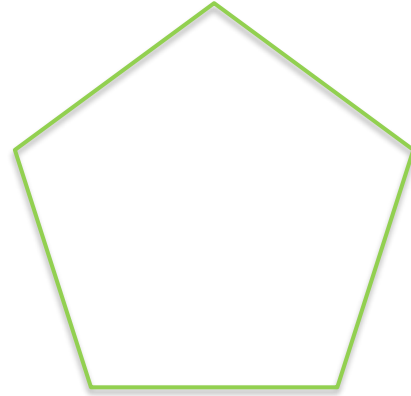
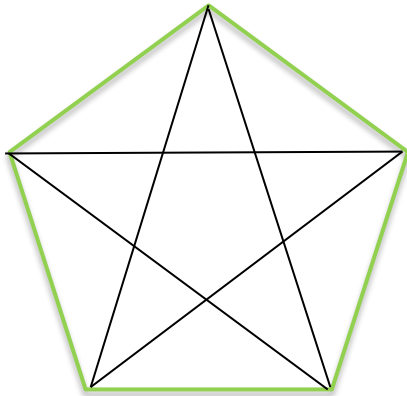
### Continuous line:

Try drawing a star with a continuous line – without taking your pencil off the paper:

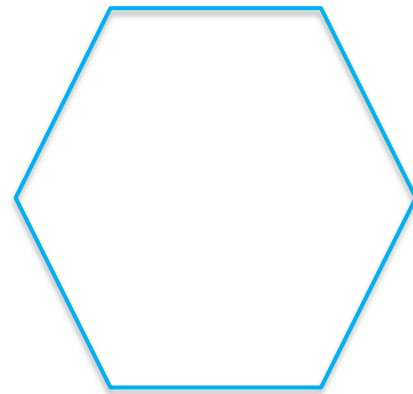
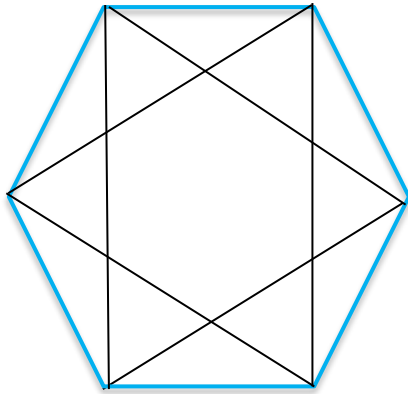


## Draw stars inside shapes:
