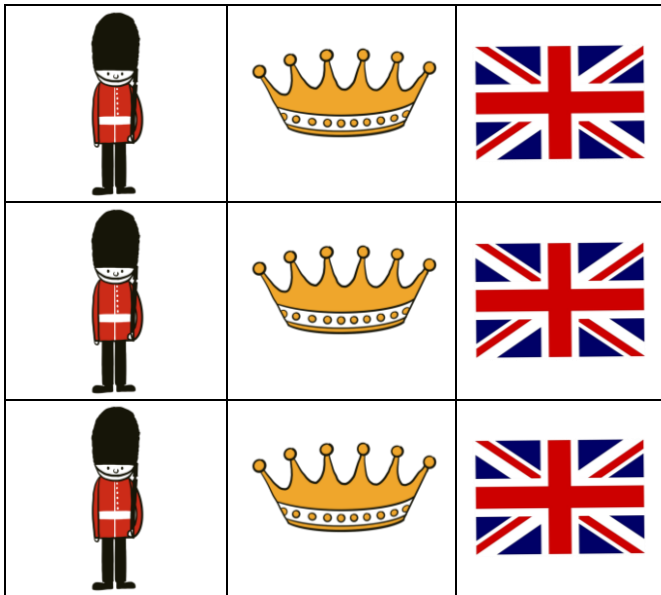
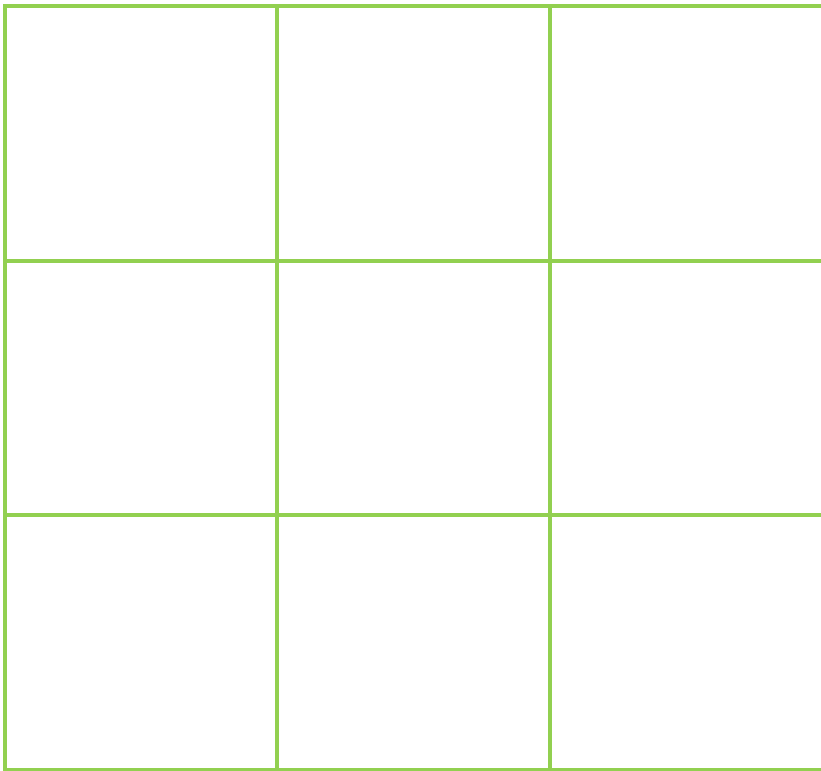


# Queen's Platinum Jubilee



## Picture Sudoku

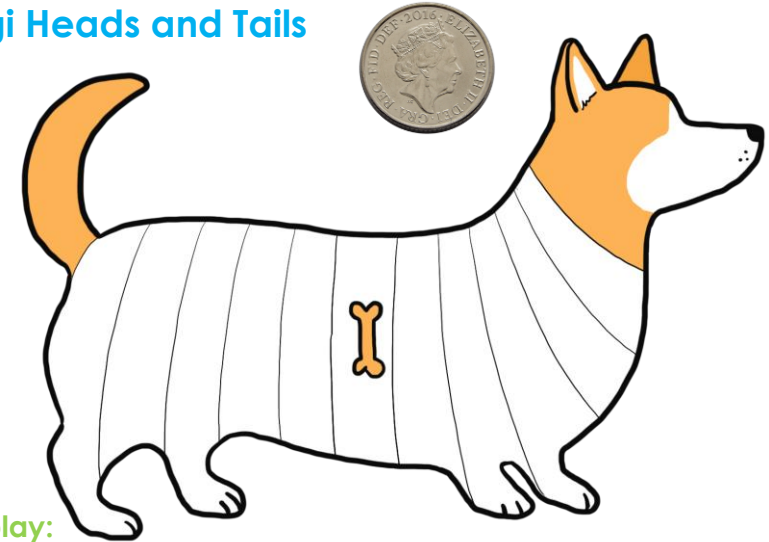
Cut out the pictures and arrange them in the grid above so that there is only one guard, crown and flag in each row and column.

## Corgi Heads and Tails



### How to play:

1. One player is heads and the other player is tails.
2. Each player places a counter on the bone section in the middle.
3. Toss a coin. If the coin lands on heads, the heads player moves one space towards the head. If the coin lands on tails, the tails player moves one space towards the tail.
4. The first player to reach the head or the tail of the Corgi wins!
