'Thank you'.


It was the most beautiful sight.


Try drawing your own stars.


Not stars-in-the-sky stars, but stars you draw on paper. A six pointed star can be made by drawing two overlapping triangles:






An eight pointed star can be made by drawing two overlapping squares:






Try drawing a continuous line:
